- Delivered new athletic shoes to 2,380 students in over 40 schools.
- Provided 15,265 books to aspiring young readers.
- Served 1,289 women and children in 7 Crisis Shelters. Delivered 224
 Sexual Assault Kits. Awarded 9 College Scholarships.
- Met critical needs for 4,079 individuals across 44 agencies.
- Delivered 8,313 Activity kits to shelters and hospitals.
