

Assistance League Outreach

Assistance League Outreach met critical needs for 4,079 individuals across 44 agencies.



Project ROSE

Project ROSE volunteers purchase, package, and deliver gift bags to area crisis shelters and agencies serving sexual assault survivors.

This past year we served 1,289 women and children in seven crisis Shelters. We delivered 224 Sexual Assault Kits and awarded 9 College Scholarships.
